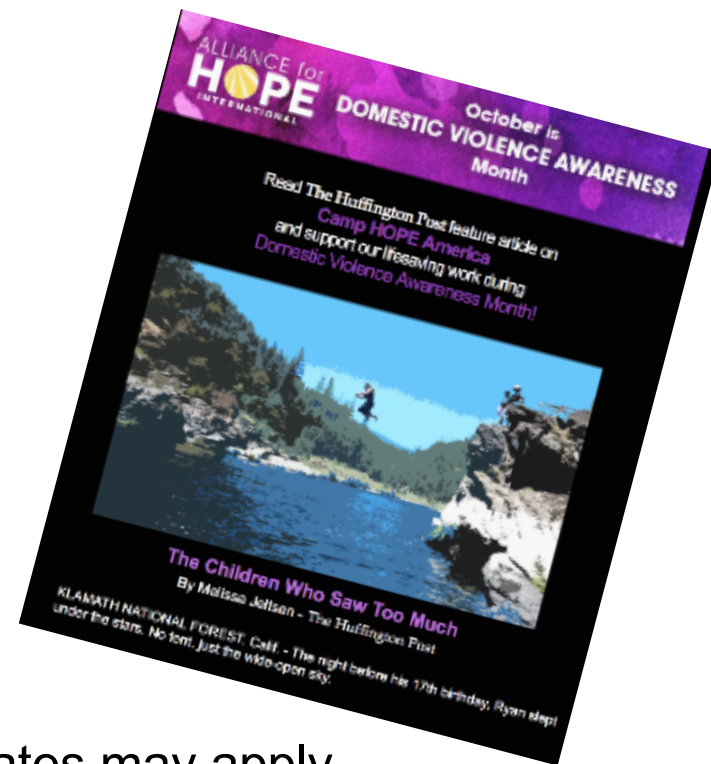

October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month (#DVAM)

- One in four women and one in seven men are victims of intimate partner violence in their lifetime.
- Three women and one man are murdered every day by an intimate partner.
- 4,774,000 is the number of women in the U.S. that experience physical violence by an intimate partner every year.
- Intimate Partner Violence is the leading cause of female homicide and injury-related deaths during pregnancy.
- Children are present in more than 60% of intimate partner assaults each year.
- 265 Mass Murders in 2015 – The Majority in the Context of Domestic Violence or Committed by Childhood Trauma Survivors with Internalized Rage

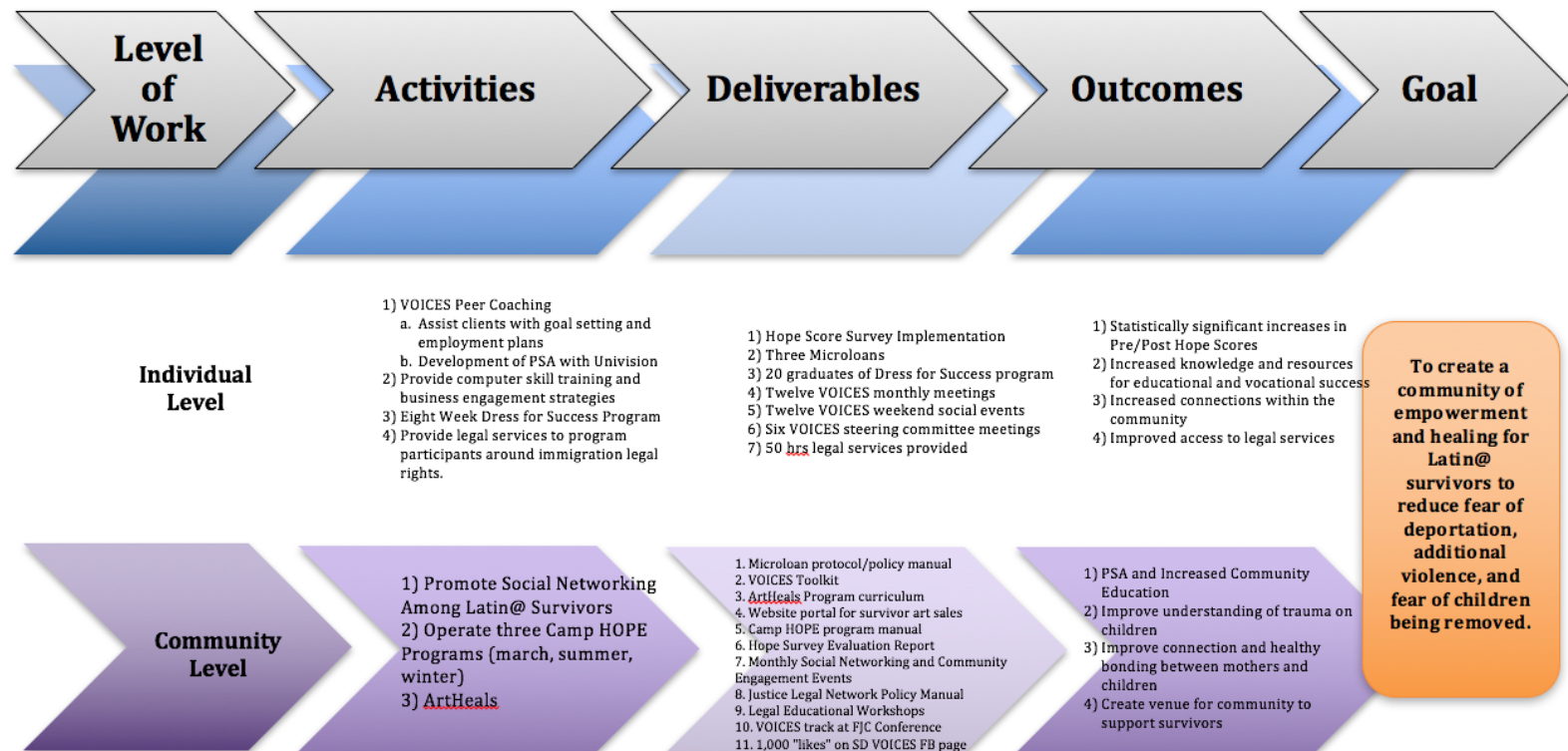

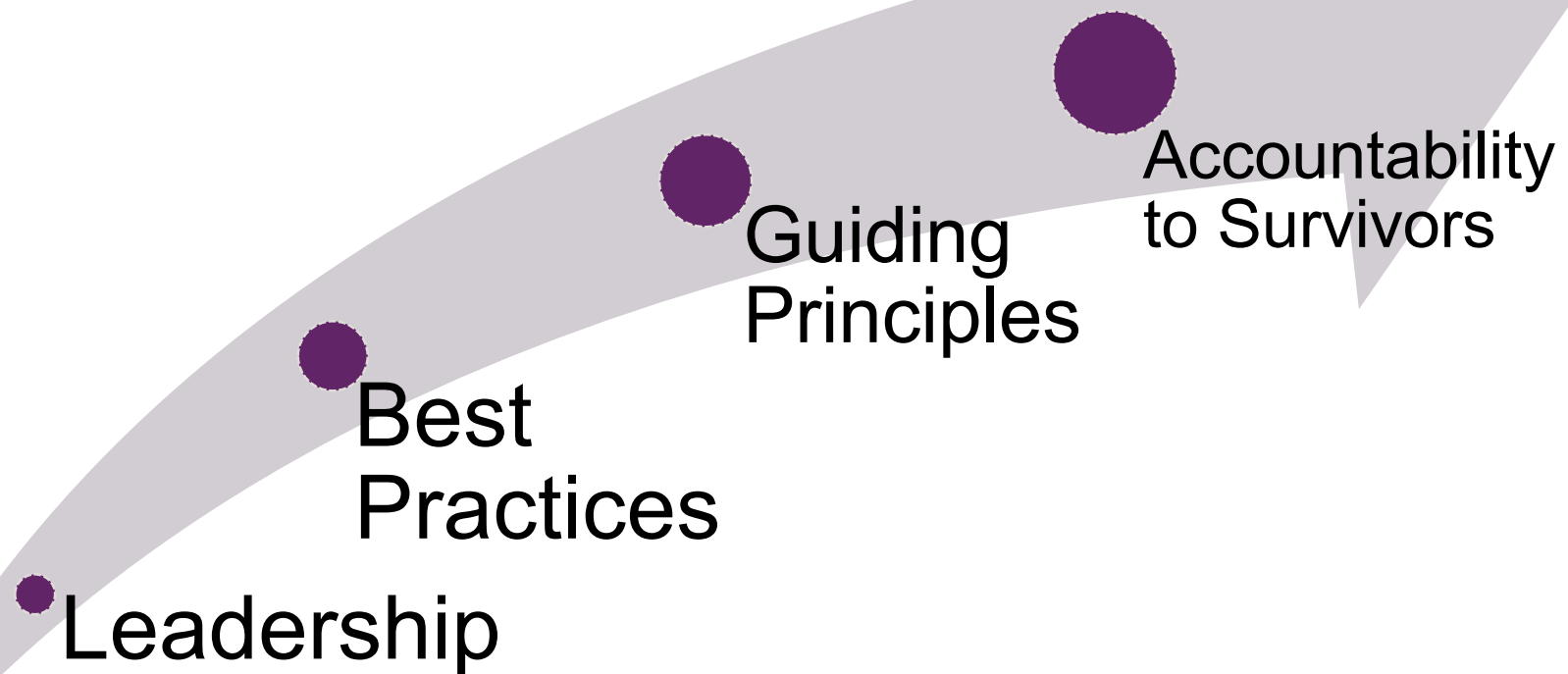

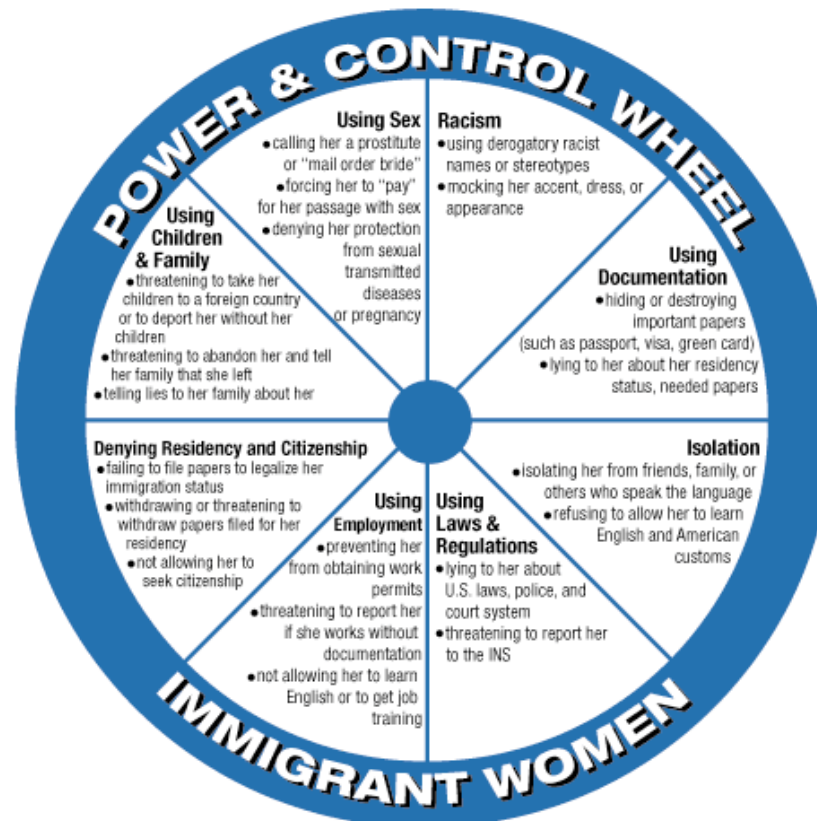


Power and Control Wheel (For Immigrant Women)

Common Myths about Domestic Violence in the Latino Community

- Privacy - If the couple is having problems no one should interfere...
- Machismo - Men have the right to abuse their wives and children.
- If you report the abuse you will get deported and/or lose your children.
- Religion - Pray and God will change him or this is the man God chose for you.
- What did she do to deserve being hit?
- He is the man you chose to be with, now you have to accept the way he is....
